With its unique location at the geographical southern tip of the African continent, the Cape Point Nature Reserve contains a wide range of vegetation which is found nowhere else in the world. Table Mountain alone is home to over 1470 species of plant. The summit of the mountain is reached by cable car in a revolving gondola. This unusual means of transport provides a truly wonderful view of Cape Town and the bay. Picturesque vineyards stretch out against the breathtaking backdrop of a rugged mountain landscape. Most of the wine estates in this region are also open to the general public and offer excellent cuisine and wine tastings for visitors.

### ***Garden Route***

### ***Climate***

Since South Africa lies south of the Equator, the seasons are the opposite of those in Europe. Summer runs from October to March and winter from May to August. Most of the country has a mild or temperate climate and is an ideal holiday destination throughout the year. In the summer, it can become very hot in parts of the North Cape region and along the subtropical Natal coast. In winter it can become very cool, at least in the evening and at night. Rain falls mainly in summer with the exception of the Western Cape region, which has a Mediterranean climate with dry summers and wet winters.
